Habakkuk 3:2

Habakkuk 3:2 O Lord, I have heard Your speech and was afraid; O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years! In the midst of the years make it known; In wrath remember mercy.

In Charles Finney's book EXPERIENCING REVIVAL The title of Chapter One is... **How to Start A Revival** The first paragraph reads...

"Revival is renewed conviction of sin and repentance, followed by an intense desire to obey God. It is giving up one's will to God in deep humility."

REVIVAL... TO REVIVE

2 Kings 22:1

2 KINGS 22:1 Josiah was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem thirty-one years.

2 KINGS 22:2 He did what was pleasing in the LORD's sight and followed the example of his ancestor David. He did not turn away from doing what was right.

2 KINGS 22:13a "Go to the Temple and speak to the LORD for me and for the people and for all Judah. Inquire about the words written in this scroll that has been found.

2 KINGS 22:13b ...For the Lord's great anger is burning against us because our ancestors have not obeyed the words in this scroll. We have not been doing everything it says we must do."

ISAIAH 57:15a The high and lofty one who lives in eternity, the Holy One, says this: "I live in the high and holy place with those whose spirits are contrite and humble.

ISAIAH 57:15b I restore the crushed spirit of the humble and revive the courage of those with repentant hearts.

JOHN 6:35 And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.

JOHN 6:44 No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.

JOHN 6:51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world."

JOHN 6:52 The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?"

JOHN 6:53 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you.

JOHN 6:54 Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.

JOHN 6:55 For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed.

JOHN 6:56 He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him.

JOHN 6:57 As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me.
