**REVIVAL... TO REVIVE**

**2 Kings 22:1**

**2 KINGS 22:1** Josiah was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem thirty-one years.

**2 KINGS 22:2** He did what was  
pleasing in the LORD's sight and  
followed the example of his  
ancestor David. He did not turn  
away from doing what was right.



**2 KINGS 22:13a** “Go to the Temple and speak to the LORD for me and for the people and for all Judah. Inquire about the words written in this scroll that has been found.

**2 KINGS 22:13b** ...For the LORD's great anger is burning against us because our ancestors have not obeyed the words in this scroll.

We have not been doing everything it says we must do.”

**ISAIAH 57:15a** The high and lofty one who lives in eternity, the Holy One, says this: “I live in the high and holy place with those whose spirits are contrite and humble.

**ISAIAH 57:15b** I **restore** the  
crushed spirit of the humble and  
**revive** the courage of those with  
repentant hearts.

**JOHN 6:51** I am the living  
bread which came down from  
heaven. If anyone eats of this bread,  
he will live forever; and the bread  
that I shall give is My flesh, which I  
shall give for the life of the world.”

**JOHN 6:52** The Jews

therefore quarreled among  
themselves, saying, “How can this  
Man give us *His* flesh to eat?”

**JOHN 6:53** Then Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you.

**JOHN 6:54** Whoever eats My flesh  
and drinks My blood has eternal  
life, and I will raise him up at the  
last day.

**JOHN 6:55** For My flesh is food  
indeed, and My blood is drink  
indeed.

**JOHN 6:56** He who eats My flesh  
and drinks My blood abides in  
Me, and I in him.

**JOHN 6:57** As the living Father  
sent Me, and I live because of the  
Father, so he who feeds on Me  
will live because of Me.
