1 John 1:3

LET'S DEFINE FELLOWSHIP:

GREEK – G2842 - koy-nohn-ee'-ah

**- Fellowship, association,
community, communion,
joint participation...**

1 JOHN 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

1 JOHN 1:2 (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

1 JOHN 1:3 That which we have
seen and heard declare we
unto you, that ye also may
have FELLOWSHIP with us:
and truly our FELLOWSHIP is
with the Father, and with his Son
Jesus Christ.

1 JOHN 1:4 And these things
write we unto you, that *your joy*
may be full.

1 JOHN 1:5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that *God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.*

1 JOHN 1:6 If we say that we have
FELLOWSHIP with him,
and walk in darkness, we lie,
and do not the truth:

1 JOHN 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, *we have FELLOWSHIP one with another,* and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

1 JOHN 1:8 If we say that we have
no sin, we deceive ourselves, and
the truth is not in us.

1 JOHN 1:9 If we confess our sins,
he is faithful and just to forgive us
our sins, and to cleanse us from all
unrighteousness.

1 JOHN 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

1 JOHN 1:3 That which we have
seen and heard declare we
unto you, that ye also may
have FELLOWSHIP with us:
and truly our FELLOWSHIP is
with the Father, and with his Son
Jesus Christ.

1. FELLOWSHIP WITH US...

ACTS 2:42, 46

ACTS 2:42 And they continued steadfastly in the *apostles'* *doctrine* and *fellowship*, and in *breaking of bread*, and in *prayers*.

ACTS 2:46 And they, continuing daily
with *one accord in the temple*, and...

And they, continuing daily with
breaking bread from house to house,

And they, continuing daily *did eat*
their meat with gladness and
singleness of heart,

Ephesians 5:11

EPHESIANS 5:11 And have
no fellowship with the
unfruitful works of darkness,
but rather reprove them.

**5. FRIENDSHIP NOT
[FELLOWSHIP NOT]...
WITH DARKNESS...**

James 4:4

JAMES 4:4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that *the friendship of the world* is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a *friend of the world* is the *enemy of God*.

LET'S DEFINE ENMITY:

GREEK – G2189 - *ekh'-thrah* –

**Enmity: *Actively* opposed with a
hostile, war-like attitude**

2 CORINTHIANS 6:14 Be ye not
unequally yoked together with
unbelievers: for what *fellowship* hath
righteousness with unrighteousness?
and what *communion* hath light with
darkness?

COMMUNION

1 CORINTHIANS 10:16 The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion [**FELLOWSHIP – KOY-NOHN-IA**] of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?
