Luke 16:9-13

**WHAT DO I DO
WITH MONEY?**

Luke 16:9 “And I say to you, *make friends for yourselves* by unrighteous mammon, that when you fail, they may receive you into an everlasting home.

Luke 16:10 He who *is* faithful
in what is least is faithful also in
much; and he who is
unjust in what is least is unjust
also in much.

Luke 16:11 Therefore if you have
not been faithful in the
unrighteous mammon, who will
commit to your trust the
true *riches*?

Luke 16:12 And if you have not
been faithful in what is
another man's, who will give you
what is your own?

Luke 16:13 “No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.”

**WHAT IS
MAMMON?**

**Mammon is an Aramaic
word describing the
Babylonian god of riches.**

IS MONEY EVIL?

1 TIMOTHY 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all *kinds of evil*, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

IS MONEY EVIL? NO!!

spirit of mammon...**

***Your loving worship of
riches is your god.***

**All money either has the
spirit of mammon on it
or The Anointing Of
The Holy Spirit On It!**

LUKE 16:9 “And I say to you, **make friends for yourselves by unrighteous mammon, that when you fail, they may receive you into an everlasting home.**

When you tithe and give offerings your money is anointed to win *eternal souls* for God's Kingdom.
