JOHN 15:1 "I AM The True Vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.

JOHN 15:2 Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.

JOHN 15:3 You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

JOHN 15:4 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

JOHN 15:5 "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

JOHN 15:6 If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.


JOHN 15:7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

JOHN 15:3 You [DISCIPLES] are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.
